

OUR LADY OF FATIMA

At the height of the Great War (1914-1918) in 1917, Our Lady appeared to three little shepherd children, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta at Fatima in Portugal. She brought a message of peace for a war-torn ravaged Europe and hope of salvation for mankind.

At Fatima Our Lady said that God wished to establish in the world devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, principally by these two means: the Consecration of Russia and the Communion of Reparation.

The message of Our Lady therefore, is a message of prayer, penance and devotion to her Immaculate Heart.

Four great supernatural events are associated with the devotion to Our Lady of Fatima:



- · the 6 apparitions of Our Lady at the Cova da Iria in 1917,
- · the Five First Saturdays in 1925 and
- the Last Vision of the Holy Trinity in 1929.

The Miracle of the Sun, 13th October, 1917









The atheist journalist Avelino de Almeida described the events at the Cova da Iria on the 13th October in an article titled, "Amazing! How the Sun Danced at Noon in Fatima." Here follows an excerpt of the article published in the anti-clerical Lisbon newspaper, O Século:

From beside the parked carriages where many thousands stood, afraid to descend into the muddy soil of the Cova da Iria, we saw the immense crowd turn toward the sun at its highest, free of all clouds. The sun seemed to us like a plate of dull silver. It could be seen without the least effort. It did not blind or burn. It seemed as though an eclipse were taking place. All of a sudden, a tremendous shout burst forth, "Miracle, miracle!" Before the astonished eyes of the people, whose attitude carried us back to biblical times, and who, white with terror, heads uncovered, gazed at the sun that trembled and made brusque and unheard of movements beyond all cosmic laws, the sun seemed literally to dance in the sky.



Spring — 1916

Our Lady's apparitions of 1917 were preceded by the three Angelic apparitions of 1916. The Angel

of Peace prepared the children for the appearance of the Blessed Virgin the following year.

He appeared in spring, summer and autumn and taught the three children two prayers to say and instilled in them the necessity of making reparation to God for the sin of atheism. But, not only prayer, also sacrifices were demanded as reparation for sins and the conversion of sinners.

THE PARDON PRAYER, SPRING 1916

In the first apparition, the Angel of Peace, kneeling, with his forehead touching the ground said this prayer three times:

"My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love You! I ask pardon of You for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love You."

The Second Apparition of the Angel occurred in summer. Sister Lucia's words:

"Pray! Pray very much! The Hearts of Jesus and Mary have designs of mercy on you. Offer prayers and sacrifices constantly to the Most High."

"How are we to make sacrifices?" I asked.

"Make of everything you can a sacrifice, and offer it to God as an act of reparation for the conversion of sinners. You will thus draw down peace upon your country. I am its Angel Guardian, the Angel of Portugal. Above all, accept and bear with submission, the suffering which the Lord will send you."

The Third Apparition of the Angel occurred in October, or towards the end of September. Sister Lucia's words:

Autumn — 1916

"While we were there, the Angel appeared to us for the third time, holding a chalice in his hands, with a host above it from which some drops of blood were falling into the sacred vessel. Leaving the chalice and the host suspended in the air, the Angel prostrated himself on the ground and repeated this prayer three times:









"Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly, and I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference with which He himself is offended.

And through the infinite merits of his most Sacred Heart, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of You the conversion of poor sinners."

From Sister Lucia's Memoirs:

From Sister Lucia's Memoirs:

"A few moments after arriving at the Cova da Iria, near the Holm oak, where a large number of people were praying the Rosary, we saw the flash of light once more, and a moment later Our Lady appeared on the Holm oak."

"As Our Lady spoke these last words, she opened her hands once more, as she had done during the two previous months. The rays of light seemed to penetrate the earth, and we saw as it were a sea of fire. Plunged in this fire were demons and souls in human form, ... Terrified and as if to plead for succour, we looked up at Our Lady, who said to us, so kindly and so sadly:"

13th July 1917

"... you have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart."

"When you pray the Rosary, say after each mystery:

The Message:

"Continue to pray the Rosary in order to obtain the end of the war. In October Our Lord will come, as well as Our Lady of Sorrows and Our Lady of Carmel. St. Joseph will appear with the Child Jesus to bless the world. God is pleased with your sacrifices. He does not want you to sleep with the rope on, but only to wear it during the daytime."

"I was told to ask you many things, the cure of some sick people, of a deaf-mute..."

"Yes, I will cure some, but not others. In October I will perform a miracle so that all may believe."

The Last Vision 1929

The last vision is connected with the consecration of Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and its conversion from atheistic communism.

It occurred on the night of the 13th of June, 1929 at Tuy in Spain, while Sister Lucia was praying in the convent chapel.

From the 'Memoirs' of Sister Lucy

"Suddenly the whole chapel was illumined by a supernatural light, and above the altar appeared a Cross of light, reaching to the ceiling. In a brighter light on the upper part of the Cross could be seen the face of a man and his body as far as the waist; upon his breast was a dove of light; nailed to the Cross was the body of another man. A little below the waist, I could see a chalice and a large host suspended in the air, on which drops of blood were falling from the face of Jesus crucified and from the Wound in his side. These drops ran down on to the Host and fell into the chalice. Beneath the right arm of the Cross was Our Lady and in her hand was her Immaculate Heart. Under the left arm of the Cross, large letters, as if of crystal clear water which ran down upon the altar, formed these words:

'Grace and Mercy.'

Our Lady then said to Sister Lucy:

"The moment has come in which God asks the Holy Father, in union with all the bishops of the world, to make the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means. There are so many souls whom the Justice of God condemns for sins committed against me, that I have come to ask reparation: sacrifice yourself for this intention and pray."

Prayer and Penance

At Fatima, in all her six appearances, Our Lady emphasized the importance of **prayer**, in particular the daily recitation of the Rosary, and signalled her desire, in the October apparition, that all Catholics wear the Brown Scapular as a sign of their devotion and consecration to her. The Rosary is a mini Gospel, recalling the historical event of the Incarnation, the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord conjointly with his Blessed Mother. It is a most wonderful meditation of the history of the Redemption, to what Jesus and his Mother worked for us. It is a most powerful weapon to overcome the temptations of the devil, a great tool in the path to personal sanctification, to obtain from God the conversion of sinners, peace in the family and in the world.

In the Gospels the word penance means a conversion of one's life, a turning away from sin, and a turning back to God. As Our Lady insisted at Fatima: "Men must amend their lives, and ask pardon for their sins. . . . They must no longer offend Our Lord, Who is already so much offended." The Fatima message is a call for men to give up sinful practices which grieve God and draw down his chastisements on the world, and to make reparation for them. Commenting on Our Lady's request for penance, Sr. Lucia wrote: "The part of the last apparition which has remained most deeply imprinted on my heart is the prayer of our heavenly Mother begging us not to offend any more Almighty God, Who is already so much offended."

The **penance** requested at Fatima was the fulfilment of one's daily duties and the observance of the Law, that is, the fulfilment of the precepts of the Church. The Church invites all Christians, especially during Lent, to prayer, fasting and self-denial, and the reading and meditation on God's holy Word. "Many persons," Sr. Lucia explained, "feeling that the word penance implies great austerities, and not feeling that they have the strength for great sacrifices, become discouraged and continue a life of lukewarmness and sin." Then she said Our Lord explained to her: "The sacrifice required of every person is the fulfillment of his duties in life and the observance of my Law. This is the penance that I now seek and require."



Timeline:

Our Lady, Tuy, Spain, 13th June 1929 – "The moment has come in which God asks the Holy Father, in union with all the bishops of the world, to make the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means. ..." (p198)

1930's— The reigning Pontiff, Pope Pius XI (1922-1939), fails to perform any consecration.

August 1931— Our Lord to Sr. Lucy at Rianjo, Spain, in August, 1931, "Make it known to my ministers given that they follow the example of the King of France in delaying the execution of my command, like him they will follow him into misfortune.

31st October 1942 — Pope Pius XII performed a consecration of the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary making no mention of Russia.

May 1952 — There is the little known revelation of Our Lady to Sister Lucy in the early 1950s, which is recounted in *Il Pellegrinaggio delle Meraviglie*, published under the auspices of the Italian episcopate.

The Virgin Mary appeared to Sister Lucy in May 1952 and said, "Make it known to the Holy Father that I am always awaiting the Consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart. Without the Consecration, Russia will not be able to convert, nor will the world have peace."

7th July 1952 — Pope Pius XII performs another consecration , specifically mentioning Russia, but without the participation of the Bishops.

13th May 1982—At Fatima Pope John Paul II performs another consecration of the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

25th March 1984 — Pope John Paul II repeats the same consecration but no mention of Russia or the participation of the Bishops.

The Message:

Our Lady, 13th July 1917 — When you see a night illumined by an unknown light, know that this is the great sign given you by God that He is about to punish the world for its crimes, by means of war, famine, and persecutions of the Church and the Holy Father. To prevent this (the Second World War), I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the Communion of Reparation on the First Saturdays. If my requests are heeded Russia will be converted, and there will be peace.

COMMENTARY:

- The Consecration of Russia, if carried out by Pope Pius XI, would have averted the Second World War.
- Not all the pontifical acts are listed here but the most important ones. It needs to be said that none of those pontifical consecrations to date, have yet satisfied to the letter the conditions outlined by Our Lady to obtain the desired conversion of Russia and peace for the world. Two crucial elements were lacking: either the word 'Russia' was missing in the text or the consecration was performed without the union of the Bishops.
- In 1689 St Margaret Mary was instructed to tell the Sun King, Louis XIV, to consecrate France to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. King Louis XIV failed to do so, a hundred years later in 1789 the monarchy collapses to the forces of the revolution.

The Seven Precepts of the Church

The current Catechism of the Catholic Church lists only 5 precepts (2041, 2042, 2043), but originally there were seven. The last two are included elsewhere in the catechism but are not listed as precepts. And they are equally important. The original seven are listed here for historical purposes.

- I. To attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, and resting from servile works.
- II. To observe the days of abstinence and fasting.
- III. To confess our sins to a priest, at least once a year.
- IV. To receive Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist at least once a year during the Easter Season.
- V. To contribute to the support of the Church.
- VI. To obey the laws of the Church concerning Matrimony.
- VII. To participate in the Church's mission of Evangelization of Souls. (Missionary Spirit of the Church)

THE ANGELIC PSALTER

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Introduction: The Angelic Psalter (Holy Rosary) was also known as the Psalter of Jesus and Mary, because the fifteen decades of ten Hail Marys each contained as many Angelic Salutations as the 150 Psalms in the Book of David (David's Psalter). The Holy Rosary, being substantially composed of the prayer of Jesus Christ and the Angelic Salutation - the Our Father and the Hail Mary - and the meditation of the mysteries of Jesus and Mary, is without doubt the first and principal devotion in use with the faithful, from the time of the apostles and the first disciples down to the present.

The *Holy Rosary* in the form and method in which it is presently recited, was inspired by the Church and suggested by the Virgin to St. Dominic in 1214 to convert the Albigensians, who then infested France with their heresies, and sinners as Blessed Alan de la Roche wrote in his book: *De Dignitate Psalterii*. The Holy Virgin said to him: "Do you know, dear Dominic, what weapon the Most Holy Trinity used to reform the world?" - "My Lady - he answered her - You know better than me: after your Son Jesus, you were the principal instrument of our salvation." She added: "Know that the most effective weapon has been the Angelic Psalter, which is the foundation of the New Covenant; therefore, if you want to conquer those hardened hearts for God, preach my **Psalter.**" (The Secret of the Rosary, St. Louis De Montfort)

- 5. The Crucifixion and Death of Our Lord

The Glorious Mysteries

traditionally recited on Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday

- 1. The Resurrection of Our Lord
- 2. The Ascension of Our Lord
- 3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit upon Our Lady and the Apostles at Pentecost
- 4. The Assumption of Our Lady, Body and Soul into Heaven
- 5. The Crowning of Our Lady, Queen of Heaven and earth
